### Awareness, straightforward compliance prioritized in strategic plan

Our newly published 2025/26 – 2027/28 Strategic Plan, *Building trust through transparency,* identifies two strategic priorities:

Raise awareness of obligations under the *Lobbyists Transparency Act* among lobbyists, public office holders, and the public, including making information on the Registry more accessible.

**Provide agile oversight**, through simplified compliance processes, responsive enforcement, and tailored education.

These priorities emerged from extensive consultations, including eight in-person presentations by Registrar Michael Harvey across seven regions of BC earlier this year.

# Special Committee to Review the Lobbyists Transparency Act

On July 9, 2025, the Registrar briefed the Committee on the functioning of the Act and the role of the Registrar of Lobbyists in administering the legislation. The ORL's written submission and other meeting documents are on the Special Committee's website.

Government changes to regulatory colleges' status as provincial entities coming into force April 1, 2026

#### What's the change?

Regulatory colleges established under the *Health Professions* and *Occupations Act* (HPOA) will be excluded from the definition of "Provincial entity" for the purposes of the LTA. The HPOA will come into force on April 1, 2026, and introduce changes to the governance structure of regulatory colleges.

### How does this impact the LTA and lobbying registrations?

The amendment to the Lobbyists Transparency Regulation will ensure that the Regulatory Colleges continue to be required to report lobbying they conduct with BC public office holders. Lobbying directed at regulatory colleges will not require registration in the Lobbyists Registry.

## **Oversight**

The ORL has the authority to investigate alleged lobbyist contraventions, such as failing to register or report required information, or reporting the required information late.

ORL investigators review the circumstances of each case, examine the evidence and, if the contravention is substantiated, levy an administrative penalty. The LTA contains a provision for reconsideration of Decisions by the Registrar.
