## ARE YOU PLANNING TO COMMUNICATE WITH:

- an MLA, their staff or a Parliamentary Secretary;
- an officer or employee of government, a government corporation, or a provincial entity; or
- a minister (or their staff) to any office or body, or appointed by cabinet?

In BC, the Lobbyists Registration Act (LRA) is enforced by the

Registrar of Lobbyists.

Lobbyists are paid, on behalf of their employers or clients, to communcate with public office holders in an attempt to influence government decisions.

The LRA requires lobbyists to declare details of their lobbying efforts in an online registry.
